# Declining Approval Ratings for the President, Prime Minister, and Government

In its third public opinion poll of the year, InfoPro Research reveals a noticeable decline in approval ratings for the president, Prime Minister, and the government. The findings point to growing public frustration, eroding trust, and a more cautious outlook toward the future compared to previous surveys.

The President continues to maintain relatively high support, while the Prime Minister's approval falls below the halfway mark, though he still has more supporters than detractors. Overall satisfaction with the government has dropped significantly, with disapproval now outweighing approval. Critics cite the lack of meaningful reforms and worsening economic conditions as key concerns. Although some respondents acknowledge gradual improvements, these appear insufficient to close the widening gap between the public and the government.

The data underscores the urgency of bold, confidence-restoring actions, particularly in relation to the implementation of UN Resolution 1701, economic recovery, public services, and anticorruption efforts. The poll also shows a rise in voter intention ahead of the next parliamentary elections, signaling a potential shift in public sentiment and a growing desire for political change.

The poll was conducted in July 2025 with a national sample of 1,500 respondents statistically representative in terms of gender, age, religious confession, and area of residence.
